Each season, AGUA uses team standards to help guide group placements and ensure swimmers are placed in an environment that best supports their development. These standards reflect the performance, training habits, and commitment expectations appropriate for each training group. Athletes who fail to meet these standards may not be offered a roster spot for the upcoming season.

Commitment to AGUA through practice attendance and meet participation are the main factors being evaluated. If your swimmer does not meet the minimum standards for their respective training group, they may not be accepted for the following AGUA season. We will also evaluate each swimmers' competitive performance through their seasonal progress and their training proficiency to reduce training disparity during practice sessions.
